Nehemiah 3:1-32 Black Pew Bible pg. 399

<u>Keys to Reading:</u> Nehemiah has assembled a crew to rebuild the walls surrounding Jerusalem. As you read, take special note of the people Nehemiah has recruited to do the work.

Main Idea: The people of God have come together to rebuild the walls.

<u>Theme:</u> God's people share the burdens of their families and neighbours.

Reflection Questions:

- How do you think Nehemiah assembled so many people to do the work of rebuilding the wall? What might we learn about Nehemiah's leadership and our own leadership?
- The list of builders includes skilled and unskilled people. In what ways do you feel unskilled for doing God's work? What encouragement might you take from this passage?

<u>Act!</u> It is easy to find reasons and excuses to not be involved in the work God has for you. We might think we don't have enough time or talents to do something.

Reach out to Pastor J-M or a member of council this week to offer to serve; ask where Trinity needs help and be willing to step out in faith to serve our church family.
