Nehemiah 9:1-38 Black Pew Bible pg. 404

<u>Keys to Reading:</u> The people asked Ezra to read God's Word to them which moves them to repentance. As they gathered together, they reinstituted the Feast to remember the Lord's goodness to them.

Main Idea: The priests tell the people how God has been faithful to them through many generations; God was faithful even when the people were not. After hearing this, the people make covenant with God.

Theme: God is faithful because of His love for us.

## **Reflection Questions:**

- The basic biblical covenant formula is this: "I will take you for my people, and I will be your God." Where do you see God's covenantal faithfulness in the reading and in your life?
- How have you failed to return God's covenantal love and faithfulness to you? How can you make this right?
- In what ways do you struggle to believe that God could love you?

Act! Confess your sins to God: journal them, speak them out loud, and/or tell them to someone else (Pastor J-M is available for this). Then take solace in the words "But you are a God ready to forgive, gracious and merciful, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love..." (Neh. 9:17)
