

## Nehemiah 9:1-38

**Keys to Reading:** The people asked Ezra to read God's Word to them which moves them to repentance. As they gathered together, they re-instituted the Feast to remember the Lord's goodness to them.

**Main Idea:** The priests tell the people how God has been faithful to them through many generations; God was faithful even when the people were not. After hearing this, the people make covenant with God.

**Theme:** God is faithful because of His love for us.

### **Reflection Questions:**

- The basic biblical covenant formula is this: "I will take you for my people, and I will be your God." Where do you see God's covenantal faithfulness in the reading *and* in your life?
- How have you failed to return God's covenantal love and faithfulness to you? How can you make this right?
- In what ways do you struggle to believe that God could love you?

**Act!** Confess your sins to God: journal them, speak them out loud, and/or tell them to someone else (Pastor J-M is available for this). Then take solace in the words "But you are a God ready to forgive, gracious and merciful, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love..." (Neh. 9:17)
